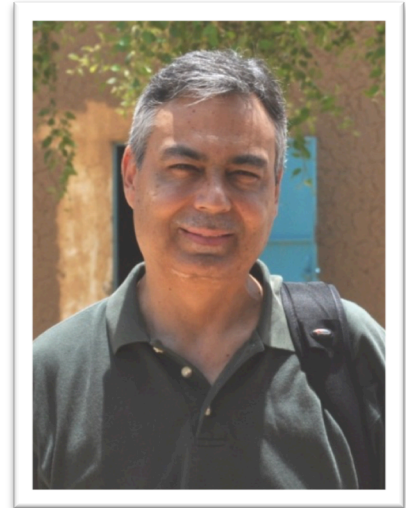


Dear Friend,

FLOOR MATS \$15

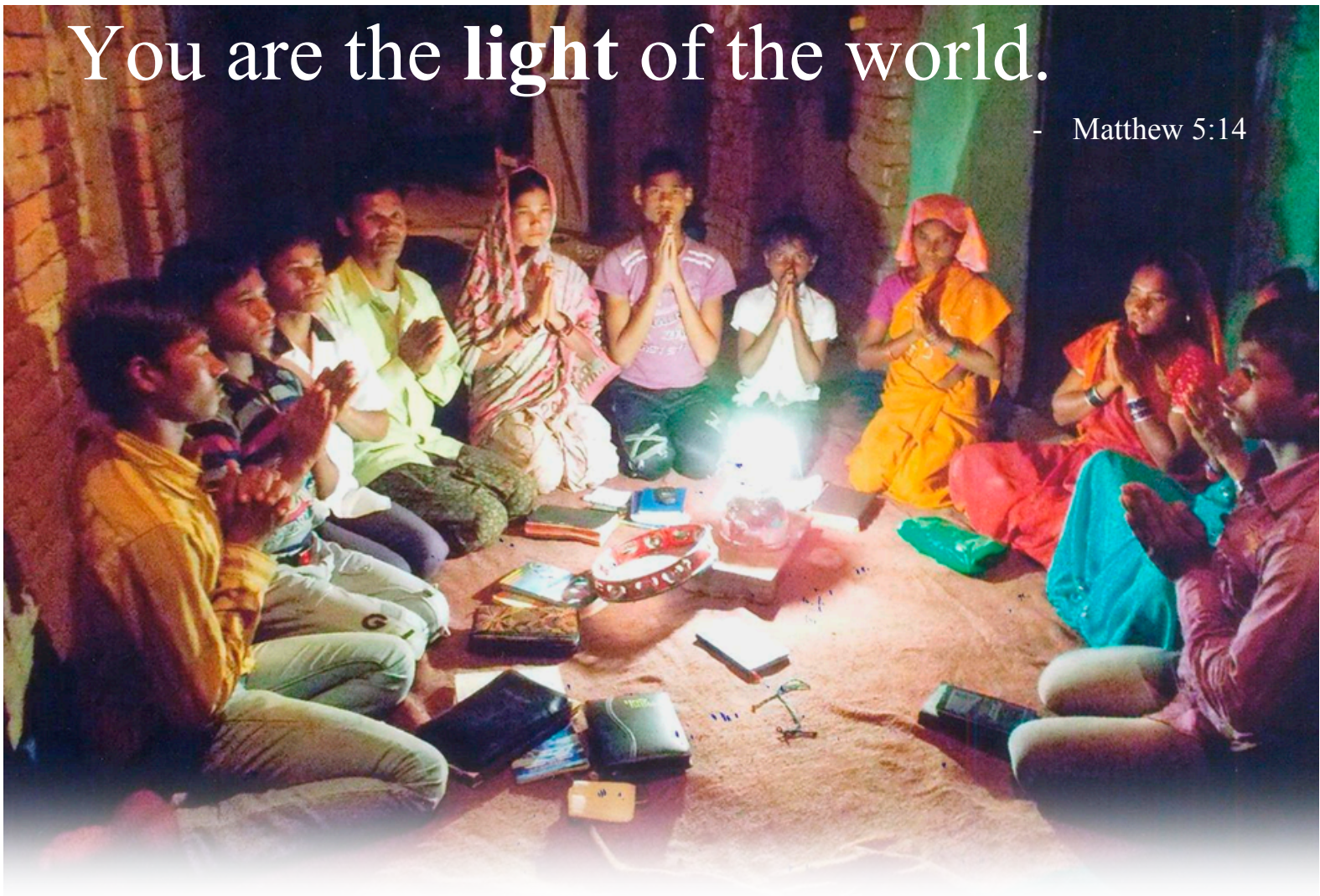
Providing Seating for Churches

Most churches in India and other Asian countries do not use chairs for sitting; they use simple floor mats. These floor mats enable the missionaries to provide a sitting area anywhere, whether they are outside, under a tree, or in a building. Each floor mat can accommodate between 7-10 people.

Gas Lanterns \$25

Light in the Darkness

Gas lanterns help missionaries when they are walking through villages at night. They are also used as a light source for night time Gospel meetings. When a missionary arrives to a poor, unreached village, the people gather together and hear the Gospel message for the first time.

Cell Phones \$25

Facilitating Communication on the Fields

These devices are key for missionaries to communicate with each other and with their leaders. Missionaries can also take photos, send reports, and get in contact with their families when away from home. Even in some of the poorest regions of the world, you may find cell phones operating. They've become one of the most important communication tools on the mission fields.



Children's Clothing \$15

Clothing the Lord's Little Ones

Many children around the world do not have adequate clothing. Sometimes the clothes they are wearing do not fit them anymore as they have outgrown them. Other times their parents simply can't afford to get everyone in the family new clothes. When missionaries provide for this need, it opens the hearts of the whole family to hear about the love of Jesus.

Musical Instrument \$25

Facilitating Praise and Worship

Musical instruments are important tools for the local believers as they rejoice in praising our Lord Jesus. They are also great tools for missionaries when they conduct outreaches in villages, where they play Christian songs and minister the Word of God. These instruments include cymbals, hand drums, air organs, etc.





Toys for Children \$10 **Bringing Joy to a Child**

There are millions of children around the world who are victims of child abuse, wars, child labor, or who have become orphans. There are also others whose parents are so poor that they can't even provide a simple toy for them. Missionaries bring joy to thousands of these children by bringing them toys. More importantly, they are also able to share the love of our Lord Jesus with them.

Sewing Machine \$110 **Helping Women Help Themselves**

Many native ministries conduct vocational training, especially for widows or single Christian mothers. Sewing machines provide a source of income, giving them the ability to help their children as well as the local Church. This enables the Gospel to continue moving forward.





Flashdrives \$50

A very Strategic Tool

In Iran, practically everyone uses flash-drives. Most Iranian cars have ports in which a USB can be plugged in, so Iranians even use them to listen to music while on the road. GCP is helping a native ministry that is using flash-drives to reach Iranians. This ministry fills an 8 GB flash drive with 4 GB's worth of evangelistic material (an audio New Testament, the Jesus Film, worship songs, etc.) and leaves the other 4 GB open as a gift to the person receiving it. This ministry wishes to produce these flash drives in mass quantities and distribute them inside the country to thousands of Iranians who are eager to learn of our Lord Jesus.

New Testaments \$3

Among Places of High Risk

Ukrainian missionaries are distributing food and Christian literature to thousands of innocent civilians caught up in the war between Russia and Ukraine. People in this region are begging missionaries for the Word of God. The pages of the New Testaments that are being provided (photo) are made out of a special material that prevents them from ripping or dissolving in water, making them incredibly durable.



Bio-Sand Filters \$85

Saving Lives with Clean Water

Arsenic is a deadly heavy metal found in water from wells all over East India, especially in the state of West Bengal. In collaboration with a native ministry in Calcutta, GCP is building, transporting, and installing Bio-sand filters that extract 99% of all arsenic and bacteria from the water. These filters are a great outreach tool for missionaries sharing the Gospel and planting churches among poor unreached Muslim and Hindu villagers.



Missionary Training \$50

Equipping Church Planters

Missionary training is vital in taking the Gospel to the unreached people groups of the world. After these trainings, missionaries will be able to preach the Truth of the Gospel with accuracy and clarity. You can help a native missionary receive 2 weeks of biblical training for only \$50.

Gas Heaters \$30/family

Keeping Refugee Families Warm

Heaters are an urgent need for almost all refugee families. Many of them are living in schools or inside some church building where there is no proper heating during cold nights. Many other refugees are temporarily staying with families who have opened their homes to these displaced people. However, many of these families also lack extra heaters for the added people in their houses. Missionaries want to provide this important tool to those who need it most. Please consider donating towards this need.

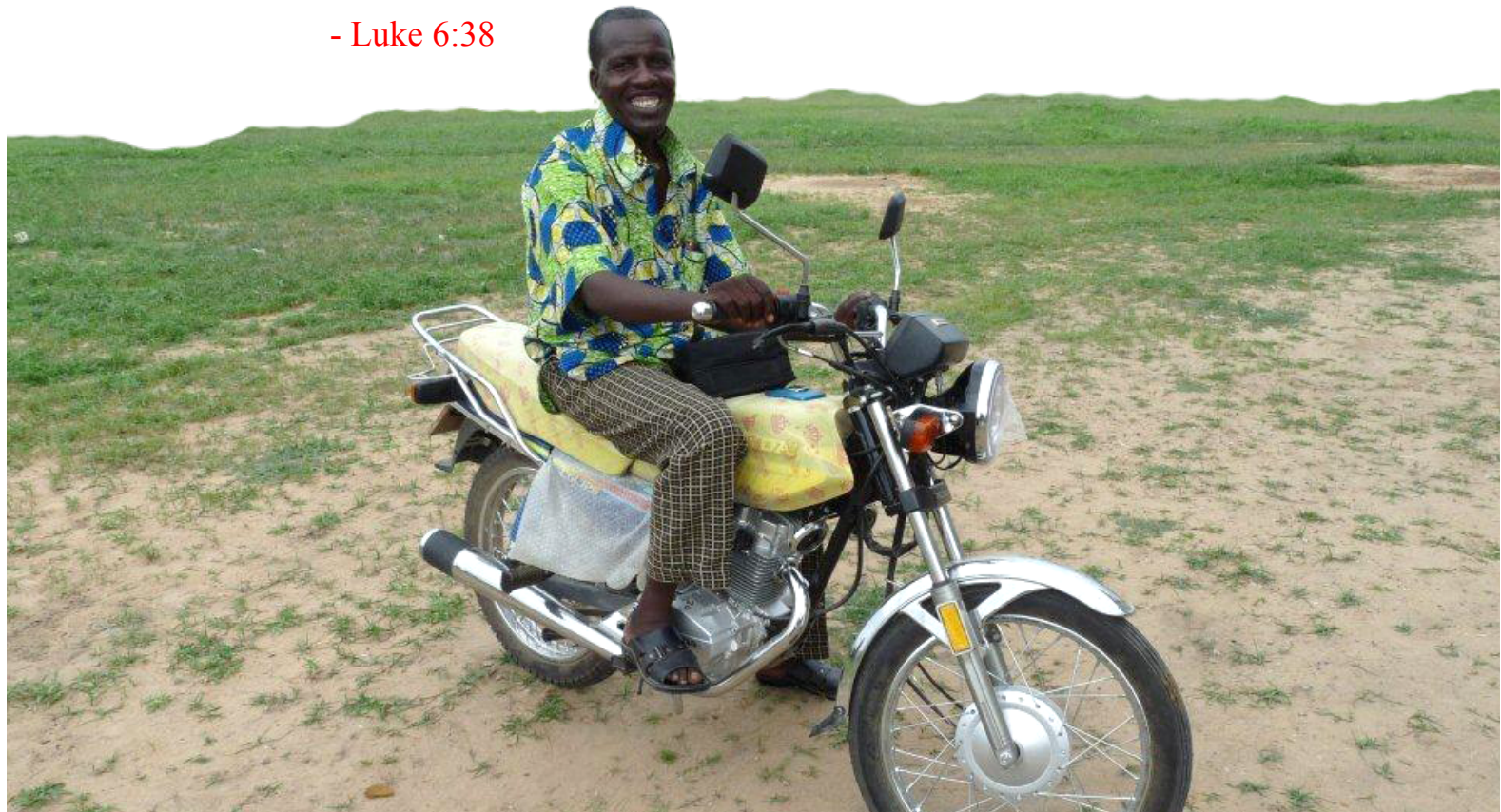
Motorcycles \$1,300

An essential tool for missionary leaders

Motorcycles are one of the most important tools in the mission fields. They enable leaders and missionaries to reach places that vehicles and bicycles cannot, while keeping fuel and maintenance costs at a minimum. They are also used as emergency medical vehicles to carry the sick to hospitals.

Food Packages \$55

Giving Hope to the Hopeless

Today, there are over 2 million Internal Displaced People (IDPs) in Iraq and hundreds of thousands Syrian refugees in Jordanian camps. Native missionaries are bringing these food packages to the most desperate refugees as a way to show the love of Jesus in their lives. One package will feed a family of four for 30 days. The packages include some of the essentials like cooking oil, salt, rice, noodles and canned products.



Rice Cookers \$40

Feeding the Hungry

Rice is the main food in most Asian countries, and rice cookers are in constant usage, causing them to break down regularly. This is especially true in all our orphanages where missionaries have to cook for dozens of children and adults. We wish to get good quality, long lasting rice cookers for these orphanages.

Mosquito Nets \$20

Keeping Kids Safe

People in third world countries suffer all kinds of diseases due to mosquito bites. Every year, especially during the rainy season, both children and adults are vulnerable to sicknesses such as dengue fever or malaria, which in some cases can be fatal. A mosquito net is a simple, inexpensive but indispensable item that saves lives in these countries. We want to provide them to missionaries and children orphanages.

Baby Milk & Diapers \$20

Taking care of Refugee Babies

For thousands of refugee mothers, baby milk and diapers are one of the most important items they are in need of. This is especially true, not only among the hundreds of thousands of Iraqi refugees, but also among the Syrian refugees living in camps in Jordan. Please consider helping these mothers care for their vulnerable children.

Water Wells \$1000-\$3000

Safe Water for the Destitute

Water wells can provide safe drinking water to an entire village. This is especially useful in areas that are resistant to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. GCP also drills wells for Christians in villages where they are not allowed to drink from the public wells just because they are Christians. Wells will greatly vary in cost depending on several factors such as location, cost of materials, depth, etc.

Projectors \$500

Presenting the Gospel through Film

Projectors are a great tool for native missionaries because it enables them to go into an unreached village and show the Jesus Film and other video materials. When missionaries announce they will show the story of Jesus on a screen, this usually becomes a village event, and the people gather together to watch it. After the film, missionaries preach a simple evangelistic message and many people accept Jesus into their lives.



Shoes for Children \$15


A Practical Item for Children

Thousands of families have fled their towns and cities and have traveled many miles by foot across the desert to find a safe place away from ISIS. Children in particular run out of shoes rapidly since they outgrow them or break them quicker. Missionaries are providing these little ones with a good pair of shoes as a way to make their lives better and to help them avoid getting their feet hurt.

Bicycles \$125

A Vital Tool For Church Planters

Generally speaking native missionaries can plant a small church of 20-50 people in a year by visiting a village once or twice a week by foot. When we provide missionaries with a good quality bicycle, we're giving them the tool they need to reach one or two *more* villages during the same week. This can result in two or more churches being planted during that year.

Child Sponsorship \$25 Supporting the Next Generation

When you sponsor a child through GCP, we will send you the child's complete profile with a photo and a full progress report every year. Your gift of \$25/month will provide your child with three nutritious meals per day, medical attention, clothing, education, and most of all, the opportunity to know the Lord Jesus.

Missionary Sponsorship \$50 Advancing the Kingdom

Native missionaries know the local languages and understand their culture. They do not need visas because they are citizens in their own countries. They take care of orphans and widows, plant churches, and disciple others to do the same. Most of all, native missionaries are the most cost-effective missionary force in the world, reaching the remaining unreached people groups.
